

Mae Fah Luang University's Announcement

Subject: Scholarship Criteria for Graduate Students (Second Issue) Year 2021

This announcement is made to revise the criteria for obtaining scholarships for tuition fees in order to encourage and support those with excellent academic performance and high potential in all disciplines to pursue graduate studies at the university. Therefore, relying on the authority under Section 26 of the Mae Fah Luang University Act B.E. 2541, with the approval of the Academic Council at meeting no. 12/2021, on December 1, 2021, the criteria are set as follows:

- 1. This announcement is called "Mae Fah Luang University's Announcement. Subject: Scholarship Criteria for Graduate Students (Second Issue) Year 2021."
 - 2. This announcement is active from the day after the announcement date.
- 3. Item 3.2 (3) from Mae Fah Luang University's Announcement. Subject: Scholarship Criteria for Graduate Students Year 2020 is cancelled. The following statements are used instead:
- "(3) To be eligible for tuition fee support, a Doctoral degree applicant with a master's degree must have one of the following qualifications:
- (a) Graduated from a master's degree program with a cumulative average score of at least 3.50 in the 4.00 system or equivalent, or
 - (b) Have publications in academic journals as in the following details:
- 1) Scientific and technological disciplines and health sciences disciplines must be published in international academic journals found in Quartile 1 or 2 of the SCOPUS databases.
- 2) Humanities and social sciences disciplines must be published in international academic journals which are found in the SCOPUS database."

- 4. Item 4.2 from Mae Fah Luang University's Announcement. Subject: Scholarship Criteria for Graduate Students Year 2020 is cancelled. The following statements are used instead:
 - "4.2 Publications in academic journals must meet the following requirements:
- (1) Scientific and technological disciplines and health sciences disciplines must have at least 2 publications in international academic journals found in quartile 1 or quartile 2 of the SCOPUS database within the past 5 years. These must not be part of their previous academic program requirements.
- (2) Humanities and social sciences disciplines must have at least 2 publications in international academic journals found in quartile 1 or quartile 2 of the SCOPUS database within the past 5 years. These must not be part of their previous academic program requirements."
- 5. Item 8.5 from Mae Fah Luang University's Announcement. Subject: Scholarship Criteria for Graduate Students Year 2020 is cancelled. The following statements are used instead:
- "Item 8.5 To be eligible for tuition fee support, an applicant must have the following qualifications:
- (1) Scientific and technological disciplines and scientific-health disciplines must have publications from theses or dissertations in international academic journals found in quartile 1 or quartile 2 of the SCOPUS database. The required numbers are:
 - (a) At least 1 publication from applicants in a master's degree program
 - (b) At least 2 publications from applicants in a Doctoral degree program
- (2) Humanities and social sciences disciplines subjects must have publications from theses or dissertations in international academic journals in the SCOPUS database. The required numbers are:
 - (a) At least 1 publication from applicants in a master's degree program
 - (b) At least 2 publications from applicants in a Doctoral degree program

However, in these publications, the applicant's name must be stated as the first author, and the advisor's name as co-author or corresponding author. Furthermore, the names of the applicant and the advisor must clearly be identified as being affiliated with Mae Fah Luang University."

6. The President shall act in accordance with this announcement, and in the event that the criteria cannot be followed, the President holds the authority to make any amendments or adjustments, and the President's decision shall be final.
