## Amendment to English Proficiency Exit Test Requirements for Graduate Students

- No. 1 This announcement has been in effect since the 2017 academic year.
- No. 2 Graduate students who need to complete their degrees must have taken one of the following English Proficiency Tests:

The English Proficiency Test result should not exceed 2 years since the exam date and a student must have passed English Proficiency Test prior to his/her dissertation/thesis/independent

- No. 3 In the case that a student does not have any of the English Proficiency Tests as indicated in No. 2, he/she may do the following:
  - 3.1 Master degree students may enroll in Academic English for Graduate Studies 1.
  - 3.2 Ph.D. students
- 1) In the case that a student does not have any of the English Proficiency Tests or has not met a requirement as indicated in No. 4, he/she may enroll in Academic English for Graduate Studies 1 and Academic English for Graduate Studies 2.
- 2) In the case that a student has results for an English Proficiency Test at a master level but he/she cannot achieve passing criteria for the doctoral level, the student as stated in No. 4 may enroll in Academic English for Graduate Studies 2 only.

The tuition fee has been determined by the university and an examinee completing the course(s) as specified is exempt from the English Proficiency Test requirement as stated in No.2."
