

Mae Fah Luang University Announcement

English Proficiency Test Requirements for Graduate Students at Mae Fah Luang University

An amendment to English Proficiency Test Requirements for Graduate Students at Mae Fah Luang University has been made in compliance with Ministry Of Education Announcement entitled English Proficiency Test for Graduate Students as of B.E. 2558.

By virtue of Section 26 of Mae Fah Luang University Act B.E. 2541 with the resolutions passed by the University Council meeting of 1/2561 on January 8, B.E. 2561, the announcement is as follows:

No. 1 This Announcement is called "English Proficiency Test Requirements for Graduate Students at Mae Fah Luang University"

No. 2 This announcement is applied to the graduate students, admitted since the 2560 academic years.

No. 3 This Announcement shall replace Mae Fah Luang University Announcement entitled English Proficiency Test Requirement for Graduate Students at Mae Fah Luang University and any other announcement, order or resolution that disagree with this announcement.

No. 4 A Ph.D. applicant must have one of the following English Proficiency Test results. The test result must not exceed 2 years from the exam date. In the case that any of the study programs have specified a higher English Proficiency Test requirement, it has been agreed to implement that specified requirement as an admission criterion.

No. 5 In the case that a Ph.D. applicant has an English Proficiency Test result with the score not meeting the requirement according to No. 4, he/she must do one of the following; (1) submit one of the following English Proficiency Test results according to No. 4 with the score meeting the requirement within 1st semester and (2) enroll in Academic English for Graduate Student 1 and complete the course within 1st semester, otherwise, he/she is not qualified for the program. The rate of tuition fee is determined by the university.

No. 6 A graduate student must have one of the following English Proficiency Tests with the score meeting the requirement prior to his/her dissertation/thesis/independent study defense and completing their degree. The test result should not exceed 2 years from the exam date.

No. 7 In the case that a student does not have any of the English Proficiency Test results as indicated in No. 6, he/she may do one of the following:

7.1 Master degree students

Enroll in Academic English for Graduate Studies 1.

7.2 Ph.D. degree students

Enroll in Academic English for Graduate Studies 2.

The rate of tuition fee is determined by the university. A student, who completes the course(s) as specified in 7.1 or 7.2, is exempt from the English Proficiency Test requirement as stated in No. 6.

- No. 8 A student may request to be exempt from the English Proficiency Test requirements as stated in No. 4 and No. 6 if he/she meets the following criteria:
- 8.1 An inbound exchange student from a university, which has a specified English Proficiency Test requirement and has an MOU with Mae Fah Luang University.
- 8.2 An English native speaker who has approval from the School of Liberal Arts, when considering his/her origin and educational background.

No. 9 The President is authorized to oversee the implementation of this announcement. The President's judgment is considered final.
