



## Mae Fah Luang University Announcement

### English Proficiency Test Requirements for Graduate Students at Mae Fah Luang University

---

An amendment to English Proficiency Test Requirements for Graduate Students at Mae Fah Luang University has been made in compliance with MOE Announcement entitled English Proficiency Test for Graduate Students as of B.E. 2558.

By virtue of Section 26 of Mae Fah Luang University Act B.E. 2541 with the resolutions passed by the University Council meeting of 1/2561 on January 8, B.E. 2561, it has been agreed to make announcement as the following:

No. 1 This Announcement is call “English Proficiency Test Requirements for Graduate Students at Mae Fah Luang University”

No. 2 This announcement has been applied to the graduate students admitted to study since the 2017 academic years.

No. 3 This Announcement shall replace Mae Fah Luang University Announcement Re: English Proficiency Test Requirement for Graduate Students at Mae Fah Luang University and any other announcement, order or resolutions that disagree with this announcement.

No. 4 A Ph. D. applicant should have one of the following English Proficiency Test results. The test result should not exceed 2 years since the exam date. In the case that any study programs have specified a higher English Proficiency Test requirement, it has been agreed to implement that specified requirement as an inclusion criterion.

No. 5 In the case that a Ph.D. applicant have any of the English Proficiency Test result not following as indicated in No. 4, he/she may do following; (1) should have one of the following English Proficiency Test result within 1<sup>st</sup> semester (2) enroll in Academic English for Graduate Student 1 and completing the course within 1<sup>st</sup> semester. The rate of tuition fee has been determined by the university

No. 6 Graduate student must have taken one of the following English Proficiency Test prior to his/her dissertation/thesis/independent study defense and complete their degree. The test result should not exceed 2 years since the exam date.

No. 7 In the case that a student does not have any of the English Proficiency Test results as indicated in No. 6, he/she may do following:

7.1 Master degree.

Student should enroll in Academic English for Graduate Studies 1.

7.2 Ph. D. degree.

Student should enroll in Academic English for Graduate Studies 2.

The rate of tuition fee has been determined by the university and an examinee completing the course(s) as specified 7.1 or 7.2, which is exempt from the English Proficiency Test requirement as stated in No. 6.

No. 8 A student may request to be exempt from the English Proficiency Test requirements as stated in No. 4 and No. 6 if he/she meets the following criteria:

8.1 An inbound exchange student from a university, which has a specified English Proficiency Test requirement with an MOU with Mae Fah Luang University.

8.2 A English native speaker who has an approval from School of Liberal Arts, when considering his/her origin and educational background.

No. 9 The President is authorized to oversee the implementation of this announcement.  
The President's judgment is considered final.
