Case 2: name of the figure with 2 lines and more

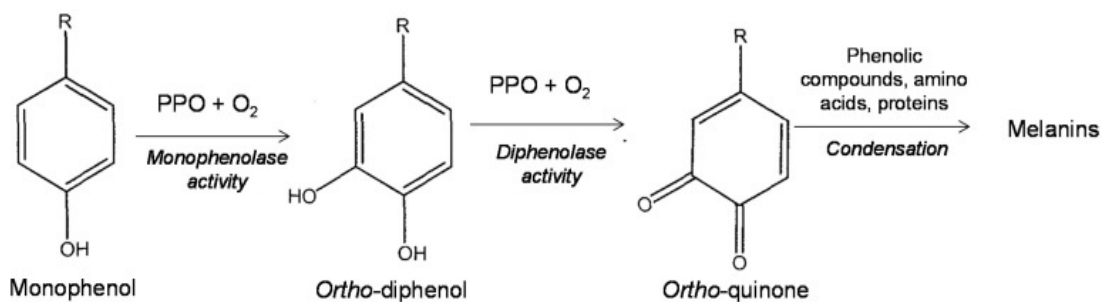


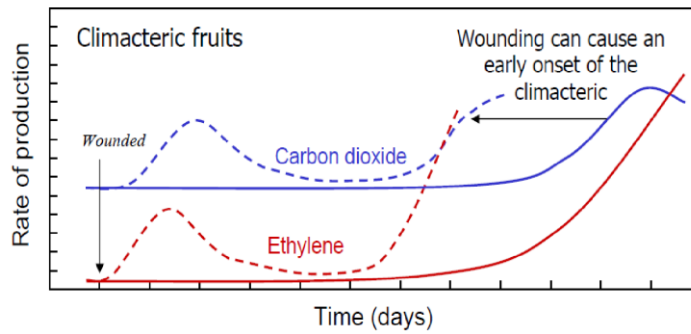
Figure 2.3 Polyphenol Oxidase (PPO) Pathway Producing Browning Pigments in Plant Tissues

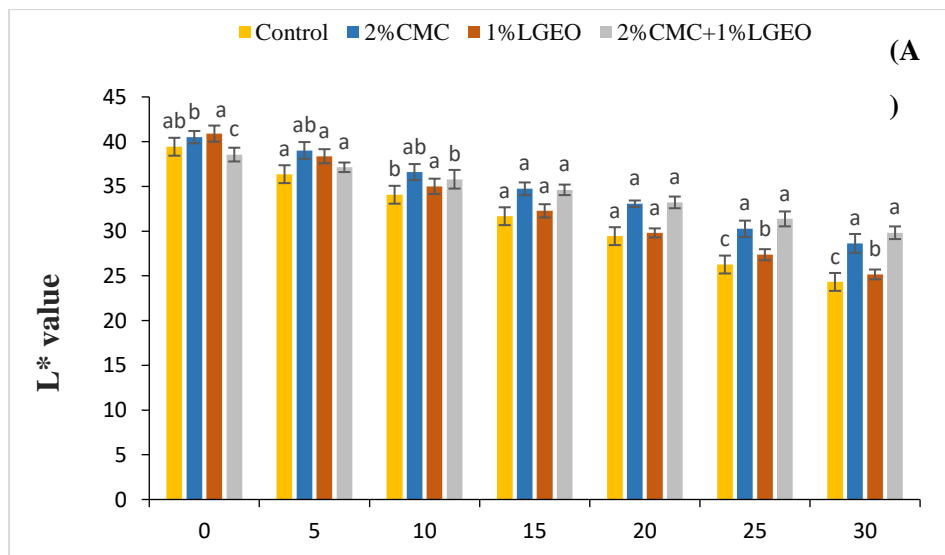
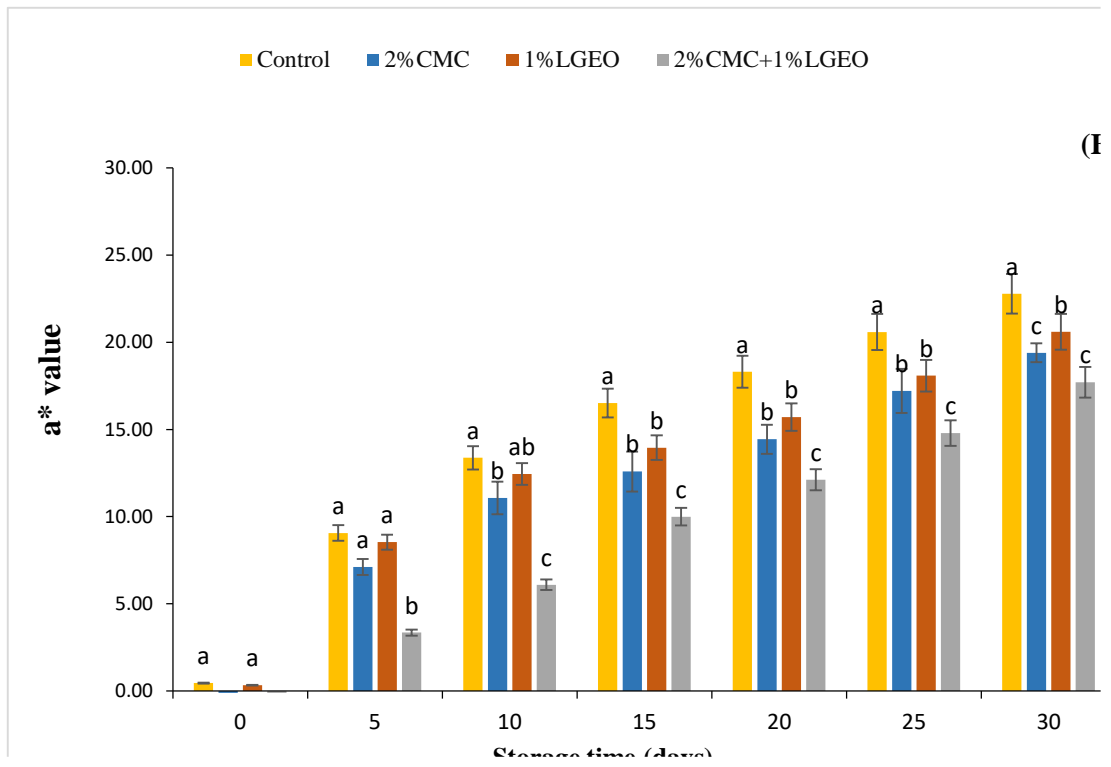


Figure 4.3 Effect of Edible Coating on (A) L* and (B) a* of Tomatoes during 30 Days of Storage at 13 °C, 85% RH
