



Mae Fah Luang University's Announcement

**Subject : Application for Graduate Scholarship Mae Fah Luang University
Academic Year 2026 (Grad MFU Scholarship 2026)**

In accordance with Mae Fah Luang University's budget allocation to support graduate scholarships for Academic Year 2026, which aims to promote and support high-achieving individuals with high potential to pursue their graduate studies at Mae Fah Luang University, as well as to foster the creation of high-quality research that can be published for the benefit and reputation of the university at an international level. A total of 20 scholarships are available for graduate students, with the ultimate goal of developing the nation's workforce and generating internationally recognized, high-quality research that benefits society and the nation. The application details are as follows:

Number of scholarships

1. Type 1 Scholarship for Doctoral Degree (5 scholarships)

1.1 Tuition Fee Support: Financial support for graduate tuition fees based on the actual rate of the enrolled program, up to a maximum of 50,000 Baht per semester. This support commences from the approved semester until the final semester of the program's standard duration. This does not include other fees or expenses (if any) collected by the university.

1.2 Monthly Stipend: 7,000 Baht per month.

2. Type 2 Scholarship for Doctoral Degree (5 scholarships)

Tuition Fee Support: Financial support for graduate tuition fees based on the actual rate of the enrolled program, up to a maximum of 50,000 Baht per semester. This support commences from the approved semester until the final semester of the program's standard duration. This does not include other fees or expenses (if any) collected by the university.

3. Type 2 Scholarship for Master's Degree (10 scholarships)

Tuition Fee Support: Financial support for graduate tuition fees based on the actual rate of the enrolled program, up to a maximum of 50,000 Baht per semester. This support commences from the approved semester until the final semester of the program's standard duration. This does not include other fees or expenses (if any) collected by the university.

Eligibilities for Scholarship Applicants

1. To be eligible to apply for a postgraduate level scholarship, an applicant must be either one who has been admitted to or one who is already studying in a thesis or dissertation required Master's Degree or Doctoral Degree programme of the University.

2. Educational Qualifications

2.1 Type 1 Scholarship

(1) Doctoral Degree (Bachelor's to Doctoral Degree): Applicants must have completed a bachelor's degree with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of no less than 3.25 on a 4.00 scale or equivalent.

In the case where the GPAX is below 3.25 but not less than 3.00, the applicant must have at least one (1) research article published in an international academic journal indexed in the Scopus database (Quartile 1 or Quartile 2).

(2) Doctoral Degree (Master's to Doctoral Degree): Applicants must have completed a master's degree with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of no less than 3.50 on a 4.00 scale or equivalent, OR must have at least one (1) research article published in an international academic journal indexed in the Scopus database (Quartile 1 or Quartile 2).

2.2 Type 2 Scholarship

(1) Doctoral Degree (Bachelor's to Doctoral Degree): Applicants must have completed a bachelor's degree with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of no less than 3.25 on a 4.00 scale or equivalent.

In the case where the GPAX is below 3.25 but not less than 3.00, the applicant must meet the following publication requirements:

- Science and Technology, and Health Sciences Groups: Must have at least one (1) research article published in an international academic journal indexed in the Scopus database.

- Humanities and Social Sciences Groups: Must have at least one (1) research article published either in a national academic journal indexed in the TCI (Thai Journal Citation Index) Tier 1 or Tier 2 database, OR in an international academic journal indexed in the Scopus database.

(2) Doctoral Degree (Master's to Doctoral Degree): Applicants must have completed a master's degree with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of no less than 3.50 on a 4.00 scale or equivalent, OR must meet the following publication requirements:

- Science and Technology, and Health Sciences Groups: Must have at least one (1) research article published in an international academic journal indexed in the Scopus database.

- Humanities and Social Sciences Groups: Must have at least one (1) research article published either in a national academic journal indexed in the TCI (Thai Journal Citation Index) Tier 1 or Tier 2 database, OR in an international academic journal indexed in the Scopus database.

(3) Master's Degree: Applicants must have completed a bachelor's degree with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of no less than 3.00 on a 4.00 scale or equivalent.

In the case where the GPAX is below 3.00 but not less than 2.75, the applicant must meet at least one (1) of the following requirements: Have at least one (1) research article published in conference proceedings, OR in a national academic journal indexed in the TCI (Thai Journal Citation Index) Tier 1 or Tier 2 database, OR in an international academic journal indexed in the Scopus database. Have won a national or international award that brings reputation to the university.

2. Must have a finalized thesis or dissertation topic.

3. The main advisor and co-advisor must meet the qualifications specified in the Mae Fah Luang University Regulations on Postgraduate Studies.

4. Must be deemed qualified and approved for the scholarship by the university's discretion.

Qualifications for Main Advisor

1. Must be a full-time School member of Mae Fah Luang University and meet the eligibility criteria to serve as a principal advisor for the program for which the scholarship is being sought.

2. Must have published academic works as follows:

2.1 For Science and Technology fields and Health Sciences fields: The advisor must have at least 2 publications in an international academic journals indexed in Scopus, ranked in Quartile 1 or 2, within the past 5 years, and these works must not be part of the advisor's own graduation requirements. (e.g. not from their own dissertation work)

2.2 For Humanities and Social Sciences fields: The advisor must have at least 2 publications in an international academic journals indexed in Scopus within the past 5 years, and these works must not be part of the advisor's own graduation requirements. (e.g. not from their own dissertation work)

3. The number of graduate students under advisory, including the applicant, must not exceed the limit set the Mae Fah Luang University regulations on graduate studies.

Scholarship Duration

1. Master's Degree: Scholarship period not exceeding 2 academic years.

2. Doctoral Degree (Plan 1.1 and Plan 2.1): Scholarship period not exceeding 3 academic years.

3. Doctoral Degree (Plan 1.2 and Plan 2.2): Scholarship period not exceeding 5 academic years.

Application Schedule and Consideration

1. Application Period: From now until 30 June 2026

2. Consideration and Announcement of Results: July 2026. The decision of the Mae Fah Luang University Postgraduate Studies Committee shall be considered final.

Conditions of Scholarship

- 1. Scholarship recipients must sign an agreement with the university under the conditions specified.
- 2. Scholarship recipients must maintain regular student status throughout the scholarship period.
- 3. Scholarship recipients must submit an academic progress and thesis or dissertation report each semester, approved by the main advisor.
- 4. The main advisor and co-advisor must remain in their advisory roles until the student completes the program.
- 5. Scholarship recipients must have their research published in an academic journal as follows:
 - 5.1 Type 1 Scholarship (Doctoral Degree)
 - (1) Science and Technology, and Health Sciences fields: Must have at least three (3) research articles derived from the dissertation published in international academic journals indexed in the Scopus database (Quartile 1 or Quartile 2), OR at least two (2) research articles published in international academic journals indexed in the Scopus database (Quartile 1).
 - (2) Humanities and Social Sciences fields: Must have at least two (2) research articles derived from the dissertation published in international academic journals indexed in the Scopus database, with one of the works published in a journal in Quartile 1 or Quartile 2.

5.2 Type 2 Scholarship

(1) Doctoral Degree

- For Science and Technology fields and Health Sciences fields: There must have at least 1 publication derived from the dissertation published in an international academic journal indexed in Scopus, ranked in Quartile 1 or 2.

- For Humanities and Social Sciences fields: There must have at least 1 publication derived from the dissertation published in an international academic journal indexed in Scopus.

(2) Master's Degree

- For Science and Technology fields and Health Sciences fields: There must have at least 1 publication derived from the thesis published in an international academic journal indexed in Scopus, ranked in Quartile 1 or 2.

- For Humanities and Social Sciences fields: There must have at least 1 dissertation based academic works in international academic journals in the Scopus database.

The scholarship recipient must be the first author, and the thesis or dissertation advisor must be either the corresponding author or a co-author. The affiliation of the scholarship recipient and the main advisor must be listed as Mae Fah Luang University except in cases where the co-author is not affiliated with Mae Fah Luang University.

6. Scholarship recipients must acknowledge the scholarship in the acknowledgment section of their thesis or dissertation and submit the completed work to the university upon graduation.

Termination of Scholarship

1. The scholarship will be terminated entirely if any of the following conditions occur:

1.1 The scholarship recipient loses their student status.

1.2 The scholarship recipient's cumulative GPA falls below 3.25 for 2 consecutive semesters, or they receive a "U" grade in any semester for the thesis or dissertation course.

1.3 The scholarship recipient fails to comply with the scholarship conditions.

1.4 The scholarship recipient voluntarily withdraws from the scholarship.

1.5 The scholarship recipient discontinues their studies.

1.6 The scholarship recipient engages in academic dishonesty, such as cheating on exams or plagiarism academic work.

1.7 Any other reason deemed appropriate by the university to terminate the scholarship.

/2. In the...

2. In the case that a student takes a leave of absence from their studies, the university will suspend the disbursement of monthly stipends during the period of leave.

Repayment of Scholarship

1. If the scholarship recipient fails to complete the program or fails to publish the required research from the thesis or dissertation as specified, the recipient must repay all scholarship received, including tuition fees and any monthly stipends (if any).

2. The following are the circumstances under which a reduction or waiver of the scholarship repayment may be considered:

2.1 In the case where the scholarship recipient is unable to publish research derived from their thesis or dissertation according to the scholarship conditions, the recipient may submit a request to the Program Administrative Committee, the Postgraduate Studies Committee of the School, and the University Postgraduate Studies Committee sequentially, to consider granting an extension of time for publication. The extension may be granted no more than two times, and each extension shall not exceed 12 months.

If upon the expiration of the approved period, as stated in the preceding paragraph, the recipient is unable to publish research derived from their thesis or dissertation, the Postgraduate Studies Committee may propose to the President that a reduction in the scholarship repayment conditions stipulated in the relevant university regulations.

2.2 In the case that the recipient is unable to complete their studies due to force majeure, the matter shall be submitted to the Program Administrative Committee, the School's Postgraduate Studies Committee, the University Postgraduate Studies Committee, and the President for consideration of a reduction or exemption of the scholarship repayment. The criteria and conditions shall be in accordance with the relevant university regulations.
